Re: Notice to Proceed with Construction and Variance Approval

Dear Ms. Prestage:

I grant your June 12, 2014 request for Dominion Transmission, Inc. (DTI) to begin construction of the Myersville Compressor Station and Suction/Discharge Pipelines in Frederick County, Maryland. These facilities are associated with the Allegheny Storage Project. In considering your request, we have reviewed DTI's Implementation Plan, filed on February 15, 2013, and its June 12, 2014 supplement. I also grant your request to: (1) construct the Myersville Suction/Discharge Pipeline realignment (filed in DTI's Implementation Plan); (2) rearrange the Myersville Compressor Station layout to accommodate the Suction/Discharge Pipeline realignment; (3) increase the size of the compressor building; and (4) construct 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. DTI requests 24-hour construction in order to meet its in-service date.

Based on our review, DTI has provided the information necessary to meet the project pre-construction conditions in the Commission's December 20, 2012 *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) in the above-referenced docket. In addition, we have confirmed the receipt of all federal authorizations relevant to the approved activities herein.
