Re: Gas Compressor Station, Marker Road



Dear Ms. Moss,

During the time Dominion Transmission, Inc. (DTI) was engaged in the Pre-Application Phase of its proposed Gas Transmission Station for Marker Road in Middletown, Maryland, DTI would submit Monthly Status Reports to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The Citizens for the Preservation of Middletown Valley (CPMV) and members of our organization looked forward to these monthly updates.

As you'll recall, in the fall of 2008:

- DTI asked FERC to terminate its pre-filing review process for the Storage Factory Project including the proposed Gas Compressor Station in Frederick County.
- DTI's "Notice" stated that when the project resumed "in a few years", DTI anticipated the need for "natural gas facilities" (plural) in Frederick County.
- The location of the compressor station(s) was not identified.

In January 2009, through the review of land records CPMV learned that Dominion had gone forward with their initial plans and had purchased the Marker Road property on December 29, 2008. While there has been no communication from DTI and no initiation of another Pre-Application with the FERC, the CPMV and its members continue to remain interested in DTI's plans for this land.

In the absence of your monthly FERC reports, the CPMV respectfully requests Dominion provide us with periodic updates for inclusion in our quarterly newsletter to our members. We recognize that this is not required, however in the past DTI has expressed an interest in being a "good neighbor". We hope that this includes keeping our community informed of your progress and plans.
